



BREAKING OF BREAD

They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.

ACTS 2



On the first day of the week we came together to break bread. Paul spoke to the people and, because he intended to leave the next day, kept on talking until midnight... [11](#) Then he went upstairs again and broke bread and ate. After talking until daylight, he left. [12](#) The people took the young man home alive and were greatly comforted.

ACTS 20:7

Just before dawn Paul urged them all to eat. “For the last fourteen days,” he said, “you have been in constant suspense and have gone without food—you haven’t eaten anything. [34](#) Now I urge you to take some food. You need it to survive. Not one of you will lose a single hair from his head.” [35](#) After he said this, he took some bread and gave thanks to God in front of them all. Then he broke it and began to eat. [36](#) They were all encouraged and ate some food themselves. [37](#) Altogether there were 276 of us on board. [38](#) When they had eaten as much as they wanted, they lightened the ship by throwing the grain into the sea.

ACTS 27:33

Therefore, my dear friends, flee from idolatry. [15](#) I speak to sensible people; judge for yourselves what I say. [16](#) Is not the cup of thanksgiving for which we give thanks a participation in the blood of Christ? And is not the bread that we break a participation in the body of Christ? [17](#) Because there is one loaf, we, who are many, are one body, for we all share the one loaf.

For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread, [24](#) and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, “This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me.”
