# Luke 1



- <sup>26</sup> In the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, <sup>27</sup> to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David; and the virgin's name was Mary. <sup>28</sup> And he came to her and said, "Hail, O favored one, the Lord is with you!" <sup>29</sup> But she was greatly troubled at the saying, and considered in her mind what sort of greeting this might be.

- <sup>30</sup> And the angel said to her, “Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. <sup>31</sup> And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus.
- <sup>32</sup> He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Most High; and the Lord God will give to him the throne of his father David, <sup>33</sup> and he will reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there will be no end.”



- <sup>34</sup> And Mary said to the angel, “How shall this be, since I have no husband?” <sup>35</sup> And the angel said to her,
- “The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born<sup>[d]</sup> will be called holy, the Son of God.



- <sup>36</sup> And behold, your kinswoman Elizabeth in her old age has also conceived a son; and this is the sixth month with her who was called barren. <sup>37</sup> For with God nothing will be impossible.” <sup>38</sup> And Mary said, “Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord; **let it be to me according to your word.**” And the angel departed from her.
