26. If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; if one part is honored, every part rejoices with it.

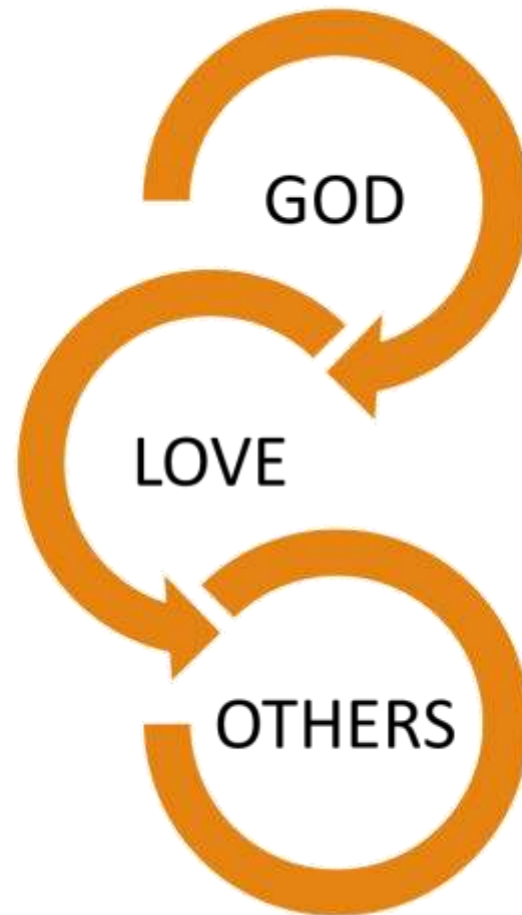
Ephesians 4
