WHY DO WE EXPERIENCE / FEEL THIS WAY?

- God created us "in His image" ability to relate to Him and experience the goodness of life.
- That image marred by losing trust in God losing the relationship – lost the abundant life – got suffering and pain instead.

Romans 1

Romans 1

- 21 For even though they knew God, they did not honor Him as God (did not like to retain God in their knowledge) or give thanks, but they became futile in their speculations, and their foolish heart was darkened. 22 Professing to be wise, they became fools, 23 and exchanged the glory of the incorruptible God for an image in the form of corruptible man and of birds and four-footed animals and crawling creatures.
- 24Therefore God gave them over in the lusts of their hearts to impurity, so that their bodies would be dishonored among them.

GOD HAD TO SAVE US ...

- God did it for us because of His love and grace, in and through Christ.
- God broke the power of sin, restored the relationship and all the blessings of that relationship.
- We become heirs of God, to "receive the full rights of sons" (Rom 8:5)
- To enjoy this we commit ourselves to God in full trust. This gives rise to the experience of the abundant life (behavior / works).

WHAT DOES "NO WORKS" INDICATE?

- Not experiencing and journeying towards the fullness of salvation that God made available for us.
- Our salvation is in Christ not in what we do.
- "No works" can be a rejection of God and what He intends for us.
- **Heb 10:26** Dear friends, if we deliberately continue sinning after we have received knowledge of the truth, there is no longer any sacrifice that will cover these sins.

DOES THAT MEAN WE WILL BE PERFECT IN THIS LIFETIME?

- From the Prophets to the Apostles to all the men of God no one perfect.
- Belonging to Christ is more important than perfect obedience.
- Christianity a relationship responsibilities necessary.
- In our imperfectness we commit ourselves to Christ
